ANNEXATION = OPEN SPACE, OPEN SPACE = NO QUARRY

What is Annexation?

1. A legal method by which a City can enlarge its municipal boundaries.
LAFCO (Local Agency Formation Commission) decides the annexation proposal.
2. Is not a "land grab" nor the use of Eminent Domain.
3. Preserves private land owners current rights.
4. Changes decision making use of property from County control to City control.

Why Annex?

5. The City of Temecula wishes to annex approximately 4,997 acres south and west of the City to keep the land as **Open Space** and to have **Local Control** over how the land is used.

Why Open Space?

6. The City of Temecula has had an official interest in keeping this acreage as open space since it was included in their 1993 General Plan.



Open space includes the "Santa Margarita Ecological Reserve"
